Well organised programs offer our campers opportunities to participate in fun activities in a supportive and encouraging community environment. Camps are held in every set of school holidays and on weekends during the school term.

KIDS' CAMPS.....

-  offers over 250 camp placements each year with the support of over 150 volunteers who care for the children during camp.
-  ensures all volunteer Leaders are assigned up to 3 children based on the care needs and personalities of the children.
-  employs camp Supervisors who run each camp and handle all medication, first aid and support the team with assistance and advice.
-  provides meaningful practical assessment places for students in Tertiary Education.
-  requires all volunteers to have a current Working With Children card and police clearance (we can help you apply for these).
-  is all about having FUN.
-  have a volunteer reward program full of great prizes and awards.

How to Join the Kids' Camps Team as a Volunteer Camp Leader

If you are 17 years of age or over and have a genuine interest in working with children then this may be the volunteer position for you.
